Annoucement about order

Ordering Party - Gdańsk University of Technology, Faculty of Electronics, Telecommunications and Informatics, acting pursuant to Art. 11 sec. point 1) of the Act of September 11, 2019. The Public Procurement Law (Journal of Laws of 2019, item 2019, as amended) informs about the intention to award a contract for the supply of a breath sampling kit for the needs of the Faculty of Electronics, Telecommunications and Informatics of the Gdańsk University of Technology.

1. Detailed description of the subject of the contract:

- 1) The subject of the contract is the delivery of a breath sampling set adapted to carry out measurements in high humidity conditions for the needs of the project implemented at the Faculty of Electronics and Telecommunications of the Gdańsk University of Technology.
- 2) A detailed description:
 - Integration with SprintIR-W optical sensor used for carbon dioxide detection
 - Sampling efficiency ≥ 500 ml/min
 - Supply voltage: 3.3V lub 5V
 - Supply current ≤ 200 mA
 - Kit weight should not exceed 1 kg
- 3) The subject of the contract was specified by indicating objective technical quality features.
- 4) CPV code 31711100-4 Electronic components.

2. Description of the method of preparing the offer:

- 1) The offer should be prepared in accordance with the model offer form constituting Appendix No.1.
- 2) The offer may be submitted in writing or in an electronic form with a qualified electronic signature, or in an electronic form with a trusted signature or personal signature. The offer must contain the signature of the person (s) authorized to act on behalf of the contractor (a power of attorney should be attached to the offer, in accordance with the requirements of the Civil Code). All attachments to the offer, constituting declarations, should also be signed by an authorized representative. The scope of the entrepreneur's representation must result from the documents provided by the contractor.
- 3) The price should be gross amount for the delivery, including all costs and fees that will arise in connection with the performance of the contract and with the conditions and requirements set by the ordering party.
- 4) All pages of the offer, as well as the places where the contractor made changes, should be initialed by the person signing the offer.

3. Description of the method of calculating the offer price:

- 1) The price must be specified in Polish zlotys to two decimal places.
- 2) The Ordering Party allows the offer to be submitted in a different currency. If the offer is submitted in a currency other than PLN, the offer price will be converted into PLN according to the exchange rate of the National Bank of Poland, table A, applicable on the day designated as the offer submission date.
- 3) The price should be gross amount for the delivery, including all costs and fees that will arise in connection with the performance of the contract and with the conditions and requirements set by the ordering party.

4. Place and deadline for submitting offers:

- 1) The offer must be submitted by 27/04/2021, by 10:00, in writing to the address of Gdańsk University of Technology, Faculty of Electronics, Telecommunications and Informatics, ul. G. Narutowicza 11/12, 80-233 Gdańsk, WETI A building, room 116 or by e-mail to the following address: logistyka@eti.pg.edu.pl by entering ZZ / 366/009 / D / 2021-offer in the text of the message.
- 2) The economic operator may request the contracting authority to explain the content of the notice by electronic means at e-mail: logistyka@eti.pg.edu.pl.
- 3) Offers sent after the deadline will not be considered.
- 4) The contractor may change or withdraw his offer before the deadline for submitting bids.
- 5) The term of the offer is 30 days.

5. Criteria for evaluation of offers

When selecting a tender, the contracting authority will use the following tender evaluation criteria: Price - 100%. The contracting authority will award the contract to a contractor who submits an offer that meets all the conditions of the contract and will offer you the lowest price. In the event that two or more bids with the same price are submitted, the awarding entity will call on the contractors who submitted these bids to submit additional bids within the time limit specified by the awarding entity. Contractors submitting additional bids may not offer higher prices than those offered in previously submitted bids.

6. The contracting authority reserves the right to cancel the procedure at any time and without giving reasons.

7. 3. Information clause under Art. 13 GDPR regarding the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data.

- 1) Pursuant to Art. 13 sec. 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016. on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Journal of Laws UE L 119 of 04/05/2016, p. 1), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", the contracting authority informs that:
 - a. the administrator of your personal data is the Gdańsk University of Technology with its seat in Gdańsk (80-233) at ul. G. Narutowicza 11/12;
 - b. the inspector of personal data protection at the Gdańsk University of Technology is MSc. Paweł Baniel, phone no. 58 348-66-29, e-mail: iod@pg.edu.pl;
 - c. Your personal data will be processed on the basis of art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR for the purpose related to the public procurement procedure no. ZZ / 366 /009 / D / 2021 for "Delivery of a breath sampling kit designed to operate in high humidity environment. for WETI PG", conducted pursuant to Art. 11 (5) (1) of the Public Procurement Law;
 - d. the recipients of your personal data will be persons or entities to whom the documentation of the procedure will be made available pursuant to art. 18 sec. 1 of the Public Procurement Law.
 - e. Your personal data will be stored in accordance with art. 78 sec. 1 and 4 of the Public Procurement Law, for a period of 4 years from the date of completion of the contract award procedure, and if the duration of the contract exceeds 4 years, the storage period covers the entire duration of the contract. Documentation of public procurement procedures financed with funds from the European Union (EU) funds will also be kept for the period resulting from contracts for co-financing projects financed with funds from the EU;
 - f. the obligation to provide your personal data directly concerning you is a statutory requirement specified in the provisions of the Public Procurement Law, related to participation in the proceedings for the award of a public contract; the consequences of not providing certain data result from the PPL Act;
 - g. in relation to your personal data, decisions will not be made in an automated manner, in accordance with art. 22 GDPR;
 - h. you have:
 - based on Article. 15 GDPR, the right to access your personal data;

- based on Article. 16 of the GDPR, the right to rectify your personal data (the exercise of the right to rectification may not result in a change in the result of the public procurement procedure or a change in the provisions of the contract to the extent inconsistent with the PPL Act and may not violate the integrity of the protocol and its annexes.);
 - based on Article. 18 GDPR, the right to request the administrator to limit the processing of personal data, subject to the cases referred to in art. 18 sec. 2 GDPR (the right to restriction of processing does not apply to storage, to provide legal remedies or to protect the rights of another natural or legal person, or for reasons of important public interest of the European Union or a Member State.);
 - the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR;
- i. you are not entitled to:
- in connection with Art. 17 sec. 3 lit. b, d or e GDPR, the right to delete personal data;
 - the right to transfer personal data referred to in art. 20 GDPR;
 - based on Article. 21 GDPR, the right to object to the processing of personal data, as the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR.
- 2) Additionally, pursuant to Art. 19 paragraph 4 of the Public Procurement Law, the Contracting Authority informs about the limitations referred to in Art. 19 paragraph 2 and 3 and art. 75 of the Public Procurement Law:
- a) if the Contractor exercises the right to obtain confirmation as to whether personal data concerning him are being processed, the Ordering Party will be entitled to request from the Contractor additional information specifying the request (e.g. the name or date of the completed procurement procedure);
 - b) if the Contractor exercises the right to limit the processing of his personal data, the Ordering Party will be entitled to process these data until the end of the procedure for contract award.
